

2024: TMA Year in Review

2024 was a huge year for Triad Music Academy! It's hard to account for everything we accomplished in just one page, but here are some of our top highlights:

Location: In March, we opened our Main Studio at 895 Peters Creek Parkway in Winston-Salem. We expanded our studio with lessons next door at 897 Peters Creek Parkway in November. Raleigh inhome lessons began in June.

Lesson Offerings: We taught our first voice lesson in April and our first guitar lesson in August. Our piano lesson program continues to be among North Carolina's finest.

Student Body: TMA started off 2024 with a total student body of 86 students. As of the time of writing, our student body stands at an all-time peak of 138 musicians!

Performances: TMA students performed in six child recitals, one adult recital, and three piano masterclasses featuring faculty from UNC-Chapel Hill, UNC Greensboro,

and the UNC School of the Arts.

Instructors: TMA's teaching roster more than doubled from six piano instructors, to 14 total instructors across piano, voice, and guitar.

Instruments: In line with growing our programs and facilities, TMA acquired four pianos and four guitars.

With all of our successes, I would like to personally thank the Winston-Salem, Lexington, and Raleigh communities for your support of our music lessons. Every family that's been involved in our operations has played an important part, and we certainly could not do it all without these great people.
